For Back Pocket Productions, she was script supervisor for their award-winning short film, *Pandora's Box*, and was assistant producer for their feature romantic comedy, *Split Ends*.

Pusateri was associate producer for the 2013 Academy Award-nominated documentary short, *Mondays at Racine*, from Oscar-winning director Cynthia Wade and HBO.

Maria's first venture into documentary filmmaking was producing and directing her highly acclaimed feature documentary, *Vito After*, an inspiring and poignant look at a 9/11 responder as he copes in the aftermath of his 9/11 rescue and recovery experiences.

Pusateri got her start in television production working for Cablevision's Metrochannels, producing cultural arts and lifestyle programming. Her work for their groundbreaking *Unblinking Eye* series earned her several Omni and Communicator Awards, as well as a New York Emmy nomination for Programming About The Arts.
